Report

- Student safety, specifically around Garrison Park

- Underclassmen staying on campus more now. Comments from the community positive related.
- Outside of lunchtime huge traffic at Garrison. Adults, students withdrawn from various high schools.
- Chief of police called a couple times, monitoring that area much more heavily. Sub AP to assess. Drug counseling – this is part of what they are doing over there, sometimes coming back on campus with drugs in their systems.
- Has the colored badge made a difference?
- Broddle, Moore supervise first 10 minutes of lunchtime, stopping everyone going out the front doors at these stations. Mr. Dupont also supervises last 10 minutes of lunch, letting people back into school.
 - Can staff, teachers be a little more strict? Teachers only have 30 minutes for lunch. There's 20 min where there's really no one checking traffic in and out. Only 9 people checking 30 doors.
 - Our SROs can't stop the students unless are doing drugs. Austin Police Department are monitoring more.
 - Bedichek – group of parents, own t-shirts, monitoring, patrolling. First based on a national org, Dads more involved. Dads of Great Students (bulldogs). There's an orientation, a bit of training. What would it take to start it up? Someone to write up a memo asking them to volunteer, working with the admin to have that meeting, calendar to schedule. Money for t-shirts from PTSA?
